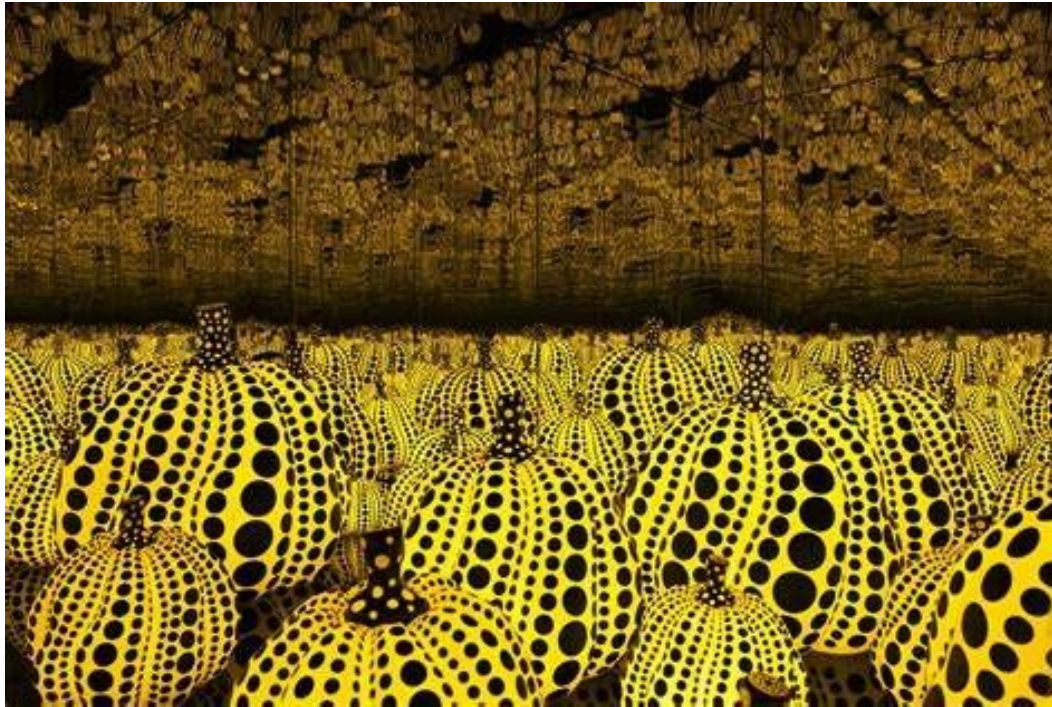


"Exploring the Universe of Yayoi Kusama"

The vibrant and unique world of Yayoi Kusama provided a stimulating platform for interdisciplinary learning and creative expression.

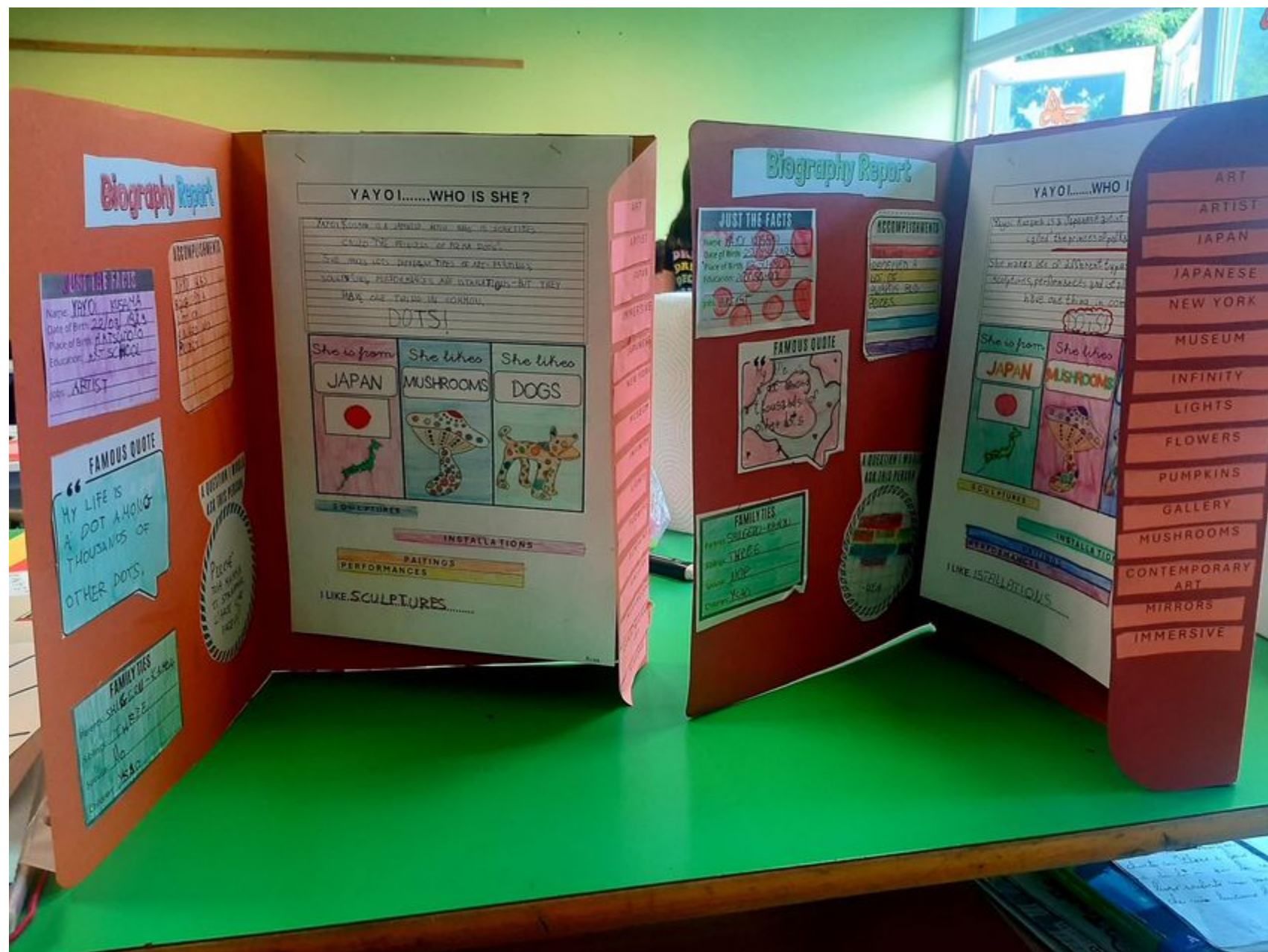






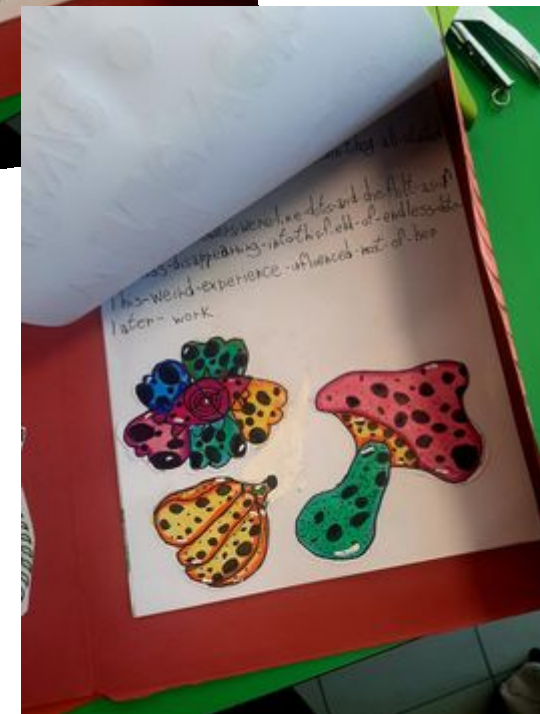
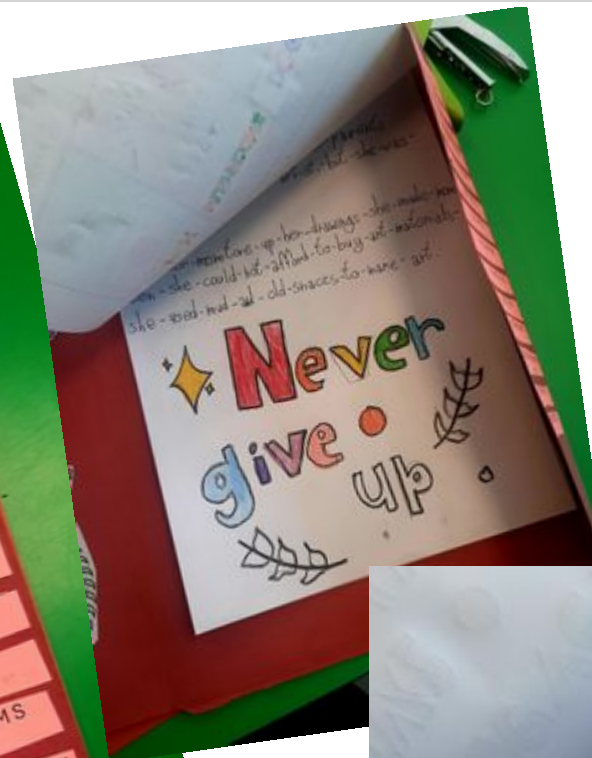
